

What is the purpose of the Success Program?

The purpose of the Success Program is to assist students accepted in the nursing program to achieve academic success in their course of study.

Who is eligible for assistance from the Success Program?

Students who have been accepted into the nursing program at Lourdes College are eligible for services from the Success Program. Students may be referred to the program by Nursing administration, nursing faculty, or self-referral. Students on probation and with midterm “C” or lower grades are given priority.

What can students expect when they are referred to, or contact, the Success Coordinator?

Students should contact the coordinator by phone, or during office hours. Students should leave a phone number where they can be contacted. . The student and the coordinator will determine the student’s needs and the resources available to meet those needs. Student’s concerns are held in confidence. Together, the coordinator and the student will work out a plan that the student can use to improve their academic achievements.
