## KNOW YOUR RIGHTS AND RESPONSIBILITIES

**CONSENT** is a knowing and voluntary agreement to engage in sexual activity.

# Ask for consent. Respect the reply.

- Sexual activity without consent is SEXUAL VIOLENCE.
- Sexual activity without consent is SEXUAL ASSAULT.
- Sexual activity without consent is SEX DISCRIMINATION.

Sexual activity without consent IS NOT OKAY.

Sexual activity without consent IS A VIOLATION OF THIS POLICY.

## What You Need to Understand About CONSENT:

- Consent is active, not passive.
- Consent is clear and unambiguous.
- Consent cannot be obtained by threat, coercion, or force.
- Consent cannot be given by individual who is asleep, unconscious, or intermittently conscious.
- Consent is not communicated by someone's manner of dress.
- Consent is not communicated by silence alone.
- Consent given in the past does not imply future consent.
- Consent can be withdrawn at any time.
- Consent can be modified at any time.
- Consent to one sexual activity does not mean consent to any other sexual activity.

#### Please Keep in Mind:

- You also have the right to file a report with law enforcement for any criminal behavior.
- Confidential resources are available to you (please see back).
- The University will typically not pursue alcohol/drug violations of sexual assault victims.
- Retaliation (e.g., threats, intimidation) by anyone against you for reporting an incident is strictly prohibited, and the University will address any such conduct immediately.
- Interim remedies are available to you (e.g., no-contact orders, academic accommodations).
- University employees are required to report violations of this Policy to the Title IX Coordinator.
- We are here for you to provide information, support, and answers to your questions throughout this process.
