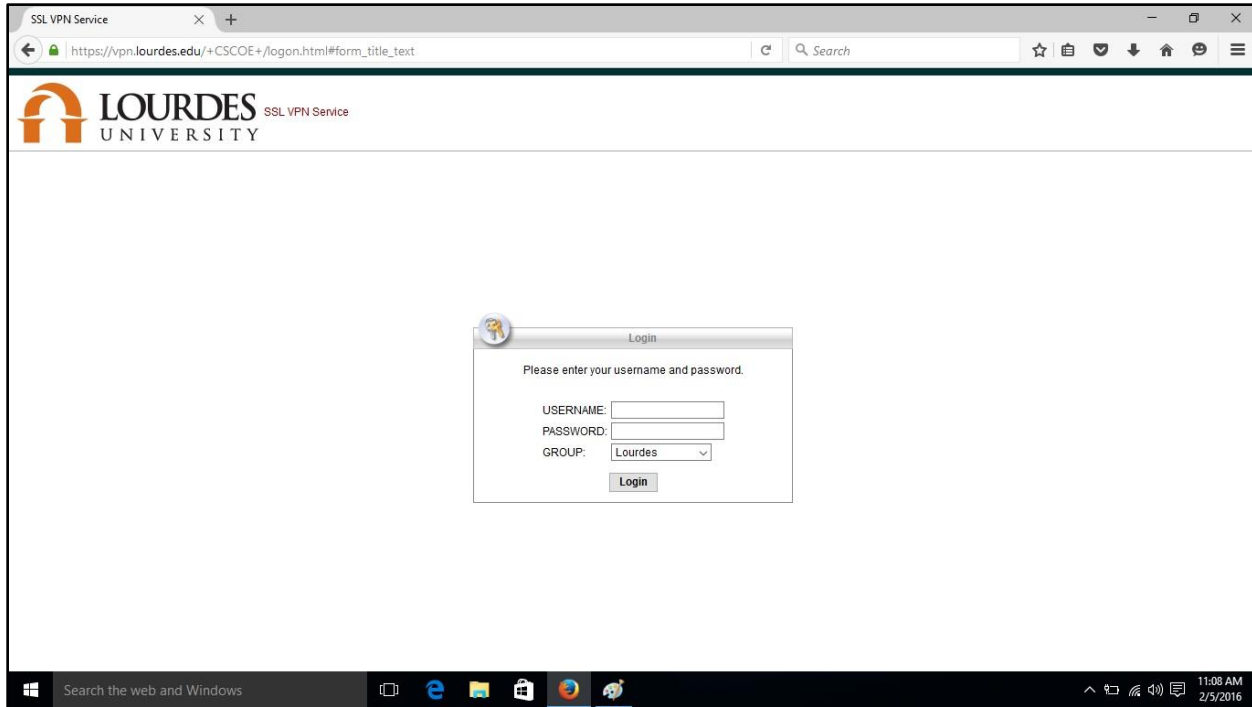
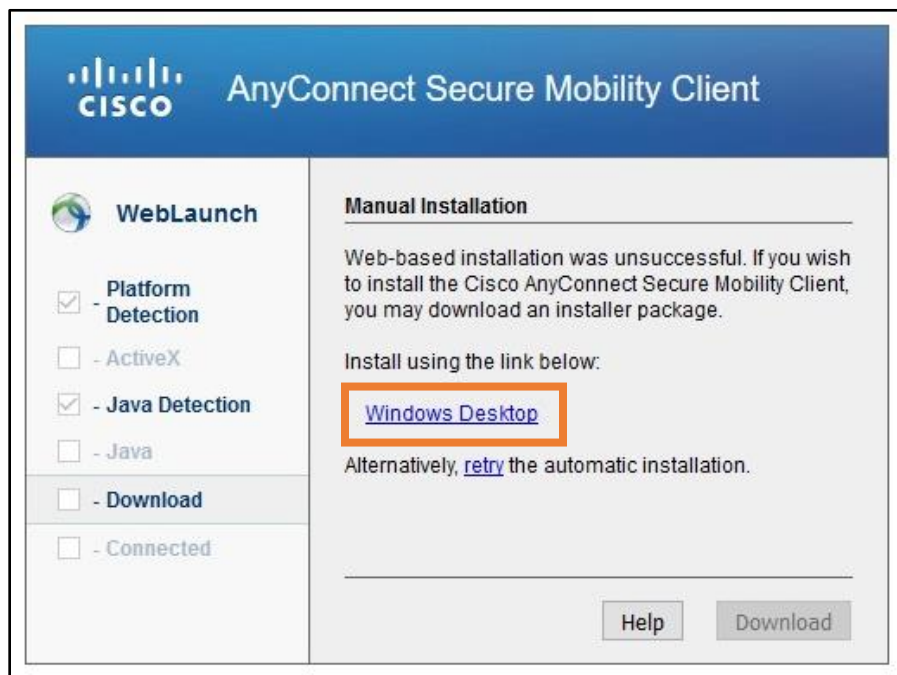


Installing the Cisco AnyConnect VPN Client

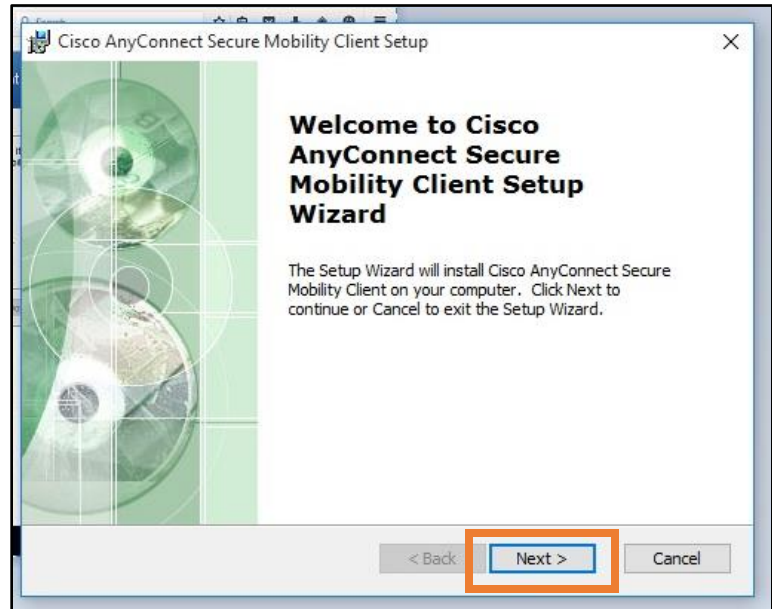
1. Navigate to <https://vpn.lourdes.edu> to download the Cisco AnyConnect VPN client. Please note that you will not be able to access this webpage while connected to the Lourdes University wireless network.



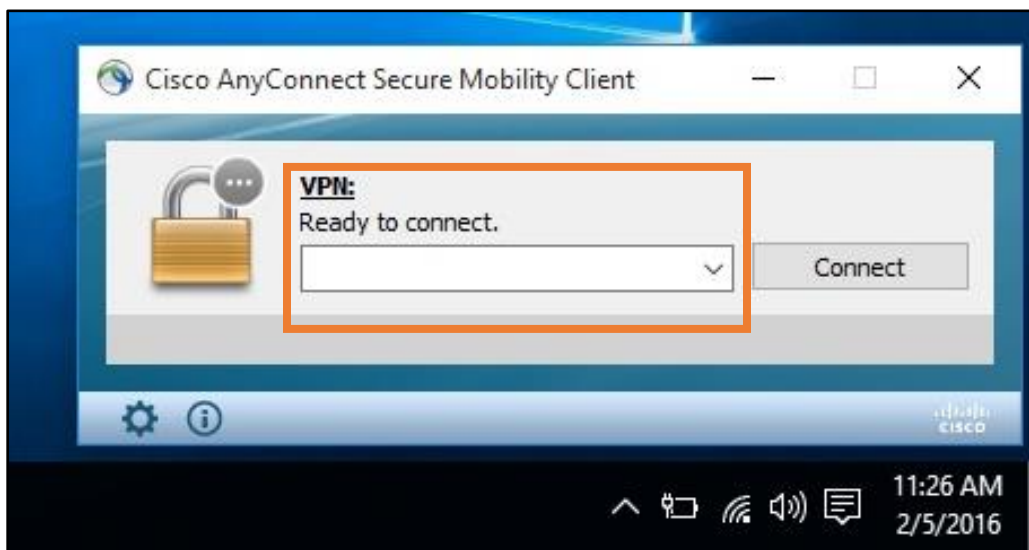
2. Sign in with your Lourdes username and password to begin the download. If the web-based installation is unsuccessful, click the Windows Desktop link.



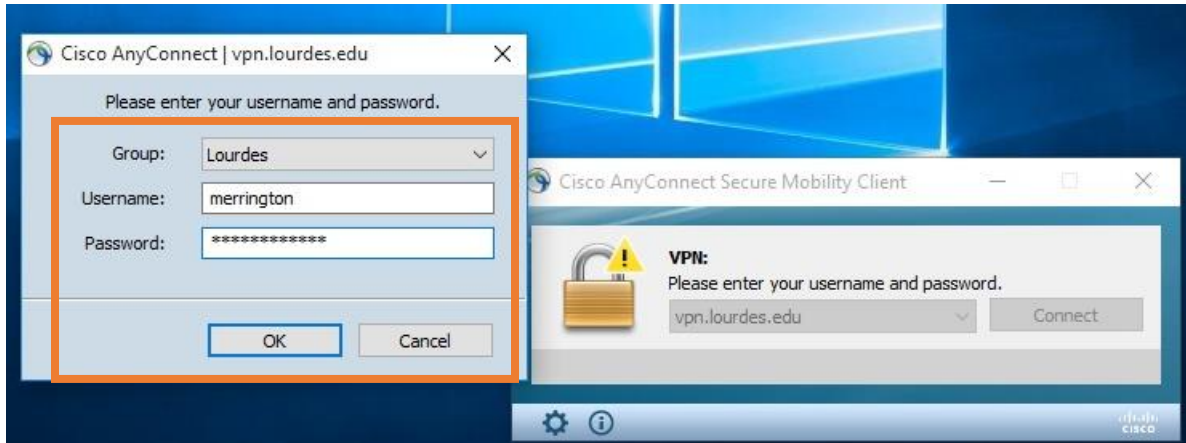
3. Go through the Cisco AnyConnect Client Setup
 - Click **Next**
 - Accept the terms, click **Next**
 - Click **Install**
 - Click **Yes** if asked if you would like the application to make changes to your computer.
 - Click **Finish**



4. Launch the Cisco AnyConnect application. If the text box appears empty, type in **vpn.lourdes.edu**. Click **Connect**.



5. Enter your Lourdes username and password, click **OK**



6. You will see the Cisco AnyConnect icon in the Task View toolbar with a padlock when the VPN connection is active.

Using Remote Desktop to Connect to Your Office PC

1. Open the Remote Desktop Connection client
2. Click the Show Options button to expand the window
3. Enter your computer name (this should be found on the white label on your office computer, ex. Rsmith-390.lourdes.edu)
4. Type in your username. It is important to include **Lourdes** in front of your username (ex Lourdes\rsmith). You may click the **Allow me to save credentials** box so that you will not need to enter your username when you connect again.
5. Click **Connect**
